### Important Safety Instructions

- Do not use the ADSL modem in high humidity or high temperatures.
- Do not use the same power source for the ADSL modem as other equipment.
- Do not open or repair the case yourself. If the ADSL modem is too hot, turn off the power immediately and have it repaired at a qualified service center.
- Avoid using this product and all accessories outdoors.
- Place the ADSL modem on a stable surface.
- Only use the power adapter that comes with the package. Using a different voltage rating power adaptor may damage the router.

#### LED Definition

LED	) Meaning			
1	ADSL:	Lit when successfully connected to an ADSL DSLAM ("linesync").		
2	LAN :	Lit when connected to an Ethernet device. Green for 100Mbps; Orange for 10Mbps. Blinking when data is Transmitted / Received.		
3	SYS :	Lit when the system is ready.		
4	PWR :	Lit when power is ON.

## Connecting ADSL 2/2+ Modem

#### 1. Windows XP or 2003

If you have Windows XP or 2003, you may use the built-in PPPoE connecting program in these OS. The following example is how to configuring PC in Windows XP.

- 1. Go to **Start / Settings / Control Panel**. In the Control Panel, please click **New Connection Wizard**.
- 2. You will see the New Connection Wizard on the screen. Please click "Next".



3. Select "Connect to the Internet" and click "Next".
