


### **ICA HM-220/W**

Please follow steps as below to know how to view in the iPhone Safari browser.


Step1. Open your iPhone Safari web browser, and insert <http://IP Address/ipcam.asp> in the address bar, then you will see the screen same as below figure.




Step2, There are four channel you can add in the iPhone Viewer, please touch one channel.(the frame will be yellow which you selected)



Step3. After touch selected channel , there is "Control command" as below (Setting / Zoom IN / Help).  
And please touch the "Setting" button.




Step4. Please touch "Camera Setting".



Step5. Please insert your ICA-HM220/220W or ICA-107W "IP Address , Port (default is 80), User Name , Password" in the "Camera Setting".

Also, you can touch the "Advanced" button to setting "Frame Rate, Resolution and Compression Level".

After insert the request info , please touch "Add" button to add your camera in your iPhone Viewer.
